- ▶ Gandhiji used satyagraha in the Indian Independence movement and also during his earlier struggle in South Africa.
- ▶ The idea of satyagraha basically emphasised the power of truth and the demand to search for truth.
- ▶ The 3 principles of Satyagraha are - Tapasya or the truth, the refusal to do harm to others, and willingness for self-sacrifice in the cause.


- ▶ **Dandi Kutir** in Gandhinagar is India's biggest museum on the life and times of Bapu.

GANDHI BEING THROWN OUT OF A TRAIN

On the night of June 7, 1893, Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, a young lawyer then, was thrown off the train's first class "whites-only" compartment at Pietermaritzburg station in South Africa for refusing to give up his seat.

A white man had objected to Gandhi travelling in the first class coach in spite of the latter possessing a valid ticket. When Gandhi refused to move to the rear end of the train, he was thrown out.
