With reference to your application dated 26/02/2014 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2018 in the following subjects:-

- (a) Languages- Hindi Core, Hindi Elective, English Core, English Elective,  
(b) Elective Subjects: Accountancy, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Geography, History, Informatics Practice, Mathematics, Political Science, Psychology, Physics, Physical Education.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school and will follow the CCE scheme at Secondary level as per the guidelines of the Board issued from time to time.
- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT Govt. from time to time.
- The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
- It will increase the number of equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
- The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII

- (b) The school is paying salary to contractual employees as per the norms for contractual employees of state or government however, the school is required to pay salary to all teachers at par with the state government norms and not consolidated salary.
- (c) Every school should organize at least one-week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- (d) Every institute will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- (e) It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahedaya of CBSE.

Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-

- 1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
- 2. The school should not use the activities for commercialization:-
  - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.

- b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchisor institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
  4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
  5. Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
  6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishakha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
  7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
  8. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, Salary and service conditions of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below.
    - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India. Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
    - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.




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9. Continuous sponsoring of students at board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
11. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.13, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
13. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and

rule 23.11.

14. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a Health Wellness teacher as per rule 53.5.
18. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
19. As per rule 13.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
20. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites [www.cbseaff.nic.in](http://www.cbseaff.nic.in) & [www.cbse.nic.in](http://www.cbse.nic.in) for updates.
