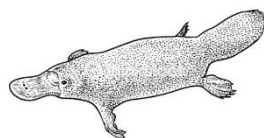

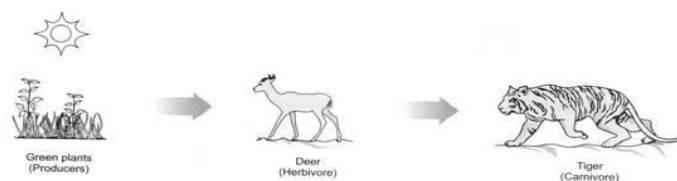


Fig. 8.2 A food chain in a forest ecosystem

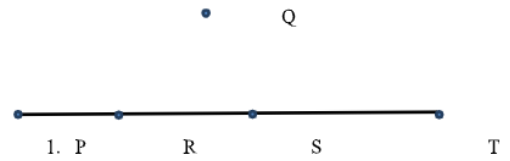
