5. New Academic session 2022-2023 for classes Pre-Primary & I will commence from Thursday 17 March 2022. Timings and schedule will be intimated by the respective Class Teacher on the day of Orientation.
6. **Offline Orientation with the class teacher** for classes Pre-Primary & I will be on Saturday, 12 March 2022 at TP Block as per the following schedule:
