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

STD VII

- 1. There will be Three Periodic Tests $\,\&\,$ one Annual Examination.
- The Scholastic Area includes one Final Examination of 80 marks and Internal Assessment of 20 Marks will be reflected for Term -I and Annual Assessment.
- 3. The 20 marks Internal Assessment includes 10 Marks for periodic tests, 5 marks notebook submission & 5 marks for Subject Enrichment Activity.
- 4. Three Periodic Written Tests will carry weightage of 10 marks each in all majo r subjects. Average of the best two tests (out of three) will be consider for final internal Assessment. However, marks obtained in the 1 st Periodic Written Test will be considered for 10 marks of 20 marks Internal Assessment for Term -I Assessment.

Details of Periodic Tests.

(A) Pre - Mid Term Periodic Written Tests - 20 Marks

(B) Mid Term Periodic Written Tests

(C) Post - Mid Term Periodic Written Tests

- 80 Marks - 20 Marks

- 5. The 5 marks for note book submission will address the critical aspects like
 - (a) Regularity in Submission
 - (b) Timely Assignment Completion
 - (c) Neatness & upkeep of note book
- 6. For the enrichment of the understanding and skill development of students in different subjects, respective subject teachers will conduct four subject enrichment activities of 5 marks each throughout the year. Out of which, two will be conducted before Mid -Term Periodic written Test and other two will be conducted after Mid Term Periodic written Test. The best one of 1 st two activities will be taken for 5 marks of 20 marks internal assessment of Term -I Assessment the best one of all the four will be taken for 5 marks of 20 marks internal assessment for Annual Assessment.

Activities for different subjects.

- Languages: Activities for subject enrichment in languages should develop effective speaking and listening skills.
- (ii) Mathematics:- laboratory activities and projects.
- (iii) Science:- Practical works / activities.
- (iv) Social Science:- Map works and Projects works
- The dates for periodic Written Tests and final Examination have already been fixed by the Examination Committee of the Zone after co change in certain unavoidable circumstances.
- 8. Minimum 75% attendance is a pre -requisite criterion for promotion to the next higher class.
- 9. It is mandatory for a students to appear in all the tests and activities. In case of sickness during tests or examination days, immediate information must be sent through application with medical certificate to the Principal. However, due to genuine reason, absence in one of the periodic Tests may be permitted where average of the rest of the tests will be taken into account.
- The performance of a student in scholastic areas will be reflected in terms of marks as well as grades (8 Points scale) in the report card, A student has to secure minimum 'D' grade (33% marks) in Annual We ightage in each subject for promotion to the next higher class.

- The primary aim of the Arya Samaj is to do good for all, that is, promote their physical, spiritual and social well being.
- We should treat all people with love, fairness and due regards for their merit.
- 8. We should aim at dispelling ignorance and promoting knowledge.
- One should not only be content with one's own welfare, but should look for it in the welfare of others also.
- One should regard oneself under restrictions to follow altruistic rulings of the society, while all should be free in following the rules of individual welfare.
