Frequently Asked Questions:

1) Why on-line entrance exam?

Our academic transactions were supposed to start from mid April 2020. As the process is getting delayed due to Corona Pandemic situation, we decided to conduct the exam online so as to ensure that students start attending the classes at the earliest. It is also a safer option during the prevailing circumstances.

2) Why was the Exam not conducted in TCS centre in each state like JEE Main exams?

Since the applicants are from multiple cities across the country and if test is conducted at a test centre, applicants might have to travel inter-city. As the conditions across various states (from where applicants hail from) are different including travel restrictions, we do not want to force travel.

3. When is the exam scheduled?

Ans: **26 June 2020** for **Science applicants only**. The schedule/mode of exam for Commerce & Humanities will be notified later.

4. What time is the exam scheduled?

Ans: Between 9:30 am to 1.00 pm (Exact time window in detail shall be intimated soon)

5. I do not have a laptop. What do I do?

Ans: Suggested to arrange a laptop/desktop with windows, webcam, 4GB RAM and 5Mbps internet connectivity to appear the examination.

6. I have Laptop, but no integrated Webcam. What could I do?

Ans: Install a webcam or arrange a webcam to appear the examination.

7. Can I appear the exam through a mobile phone or a tablet?

Ans: No, mobile phones or tablets are not permissible. The examination application being used for this exam is conducive only on a desktop/laptop. Also, to ensure that the exam is conducted by maintaining all sanctity, it is imperative that you use a laptop/desktop. Kindly arrange the same.

8. What will be the duration of the online examination?

Ans: 90 mins.

9. What is the syllabus for the online examination?

Ans: The revised syllabus has already been uploaded on the school website.

10. What shall be the pattern of Questions

Ans: Multiple Choice Questions only with negative (-ve) marking for wrong answers.
4 marks for each correct answer and -1 for each wrong answer.

11. Number of Questions :

Ans: 50 (10 Physics + 10 Chemistry + 10 Biology + 20 Mathematics)

12. I have applied for both the schools. How will I be placed in the merit list?

Ans: One common entrance exam will be conducted for both Schools, while the Merit list shall be published separately by the respective schools. You can decide the school of your preference accordingly.

13. Will there be training / instructions for how to undertake a timed entrance examination online?

Ans: You will be guided through detailed instructions and **TWO mock assessments** shall be conducted prior to the date of the **main assessment on 26 June 2020** to familiarise the applicants with the procedures of appearing the entrance exam.

14. Which Operating System should I use?

Ans: Windows 7 and above or Linux 14.1 and 16 version.

15. Which browser should I use?

Ans: Chrome and Internet Explorer.

16. Can I appear the examination on an Apple tab/ Apple Laptop ?

Ans: No

17. How do I receive the log in details?

Ans: The instructions for the exam and the log in details shall be mailed to the registered mail ID in due course.

18. What if there is a power cut during the exam?

Ans: Please ensure that you have a power backup on the laptop and a connected UPS for the desktop system when you are appearing the exam.

19. What should I use for the internet? Which internet connection would be better?

Ans: A wired internet connectivity is preferred as it would be better than a wireless one.

20. I don't think I have an internet bandwidth of 5 Mbps. What should I do? I'm concerned that the internet connectivity keeps fluctuating in our area.

Ans: An internet connectivity speed of 5 Mbps is necessary to appear the exam. Ensure that it remains stable for the entire part of the exam.

21. What other devices shall I need for the exam?

Ans: A desktop/laptop system with functional Webcam (Integrated or externally installed) and internet connectivity is enough.

22. Shall we have audio/Video Questions for the entrance exam?

Ans: No. MCQs only .
